ST. AMBROSE OPENS PLAYOFFS AT SIOUX FALLS

For the fourth straight year, St. Ambrose qualified for the NAIA Football Championship Series. The #15 Bees will visit #2 Sioux Falls (S.D.) in a first-round game today.

SAU is 8-3 overall and won the Mid-States Football Association Midwest League with a 6-1 conference mark. The Bees have made 10 previous appearances in the NAIA playoffs, compiling a 3-10 record.

Sioux Falls is 10-0 and has won 32 straight home games. USF has finished the regular season undefeated three straight years. The champions of the Great Plains Athletic Conference recorded six shutouts this season and forced two opponents into negative total yardage. The Cougars are the top-ranked team in all major defensive categories - scoring defense (5.7 ppg), total defense (92.9 ypg), rushing defense (11.7 ypg) and passing defense (81.2 ypg).

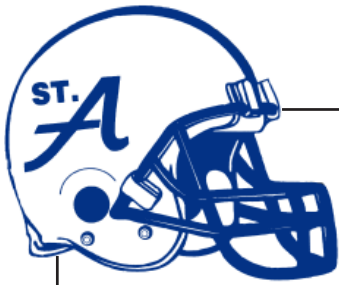
USF has appeared in 14 NAIA post-season tournaments, including eight straight. The Cougars are 25-11 in playoff games and won National titles in 1996 and 2006. Sioux Falls has advanced to the NAIA semifinals three straight times.

This is the first-ever meeting between the two schools.

Previous Playoff Experience: This is the 11th season St. Ambrose has qualified for post-season play. SAU is 3-10 overall. In 1984, 1985 and 1987, SAU competed in the NAIA Division II playoffs. Here is a look at the program's previous results:

Championship Series Appearances: St. Ambrose is making its eighth appearance in the NAIA Championship Series since 2000, which is tied for the third-most appearances among active schools. The Bees have appeared in the playoffs in 2000-03 and 2005-08. Saint Francis (Ind.) and Carroll (Mont.) have each made nine appearances. With the fourth straight appearance coming this year, SAU has the fifth-longest active streak. Saint Francis (Ind.) has made 10 straight, Carroll (Mont.) nine, Sioux Falls (S.D.) eight and Morningside (Iowa) five.

Winning Tradition: Since 2000, St. Ambrose has won 74 games, the sixth-most in the NAIA. Here is a look at the top-10 winningest NAIA football programs since 2000:

Conference Dominance: St. Ambrose has won three straight Mid-States Football Association Midwest League titles. SAU saw its 18-game MSFA Midwest Division winning streak come to an end with a 21-7 loss to McKendree on Oct. 18. It was the first conference loss for the Bees since Nov. 5, 2005, when the team dropped a 41-9 decision at McKendree. SAU is 26-3 in its last 29 conference games.

Players of the Week: Michael Hayward (9 receptions, 212 yards, 3 TD) was named the MSFA Midwest League Offensive Player of the Week while Colin Green (5 tackles, 1 TFL, conference-record-tying 3 interceptions, 3 pass breakups) won the defensive honor on Nov. 10. The pair join Billy Rembold (Nov. 3), Mike LaRocco (Oct. 13) and Will Ducey (Oct. 6) as Bees who earned the weekly award.

Away from Home: The Bees have a 37-14 record on the road, including a 4-2 mark this year, dating back to 2000.

Winning the Turnover Battle: St. Ambrose is 5th in the country in turnover margin (+1.4/game). SAU has forced 31 turnovers and committed only 16. The Bees have scored 15 times after opponent turnovers for a total of 93 points.

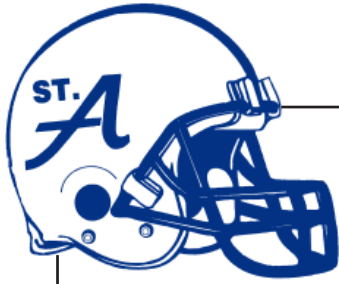
Climbing the Charts: Mike Walter set a school record with 12 sacks this season. He is also tied for 2nd all-time with 18.5 tackles-for-loss this year. Vince Fillipp is fourth all-time at SAU with 13 career sacks. Will Ducey is in top-5 in four single-season categories - 3rd in completions (216), 3rd in total offense (2,798 yards), 4th in passing yards (2,817 yards) and 4th in passing touchdowns (21).

Receiving Records: With 82 receptions for 1,219 yards and 11 touchdowns, Michael Hayward set single-season records for receptions and receiving yards and is tied for the single-season TD mark this season. He shares the TD record with Tyler Driscoll (2007) and Tom Broders (1980) share the TD reception mark with 11 each.

In Good Hands: Michael Hayward set SAU records for career TD receptions and career receptions already this season. He is 2nd in career receiving yards. Kyle Korth is 2nd in career receptions and 3rd in career receiving yards. Here is a look at their career numbers:

St. Ambrose Head Coach Mike Magistrelli

In two years at the helm, Mike Magistrelli has now taken the St. Ambrose Fighting Bees football program to two NAIA Playoff appearances. Magistrelli took the reigns of the St. Ambrose Fighting Bees football program in 2007 and won the Mid-States Football Association Midwest League championship in his first year. He has a career record of 16-6, including an 8-3 mark in 2008.

In 2007, the Bees were 8-3 overall and 7-0 in MSFA Midwest League play. The season ended with a 33-27 loss to Saint Xavier in the NAIA playoffs. St. Ambrose led the MSFA in scoring defense (allowing only 12.8 points per game) and pass defense (allowing only 134.7 passing yards per game). The team was second in the conference in total defense, surrendering just over 288 yards per contest.

A two-time all-conference quarterback at Coe College, Magistrelli began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at St. Ambrose from 1997-99.

He returned to Coe in 1999 and served as the quarterback coach and recruiting coordinator for three seasons. In 2000, his quarterback set the single-season Iowa Conference record by throwing for 2,275 yards. Magistrelli was promoted to defensive coordinator at Coe in 2001, and the following year, the Kohawks won their first conference championship in school history.

After five seasons at Coe, Magistrelli came back to St. Ambrose in 2004 as the defensive coordinator under head coach Todd Sturdy. He remained the defensive coordinator through the 2006 season before taking the helm in 2007.

Magistrelli received his bachelor's degree in Elementary Education from Coe in 1997 and his master's in Post-Secondary Disability Services from St. Ambrose in 1999.

He currently resides in Bettendorf, Iowa, with his wife Lisa and their three children, Paige, Brooke and Matthew.

Sioux Falls (S.D.) Head Coach Kalen DeBoer

University of Sioux Falls head football coach Kalen DeBoer is in his fourth year at the helm of the Cougar program. DeBoer has compiled a 48-3 overall record and a 9-2 postseason mark, which includes a national title in 2006.

DeBoer's 2006 team was a perfect 14-0 and was crowned NAIA Football National Champions after beating Saint Francis (Ind.), 23-19, marking the second national title in school history. At 32, DeBoer became one of the youngest head coaches to ever win a national title. That year DeBoer was also named the NAIA coach of the year.

DeBoer has been an integral part in all of USF's national title game appearances, winning as a player in 1996, serving as an assistant coach on the national runner-up 2001 team and head coaching the Cougars to a national runner-up finish in 2007.

From 2006-07, the Cougars had a school-record 27-game winning streak that ended in a 17-9 loss to Carroll College (Mont.) in the 2007 national title game. Overall, the Cougars have won 28 straight home games and 63 of their last 64 conference games heading into 2008.

In 2007, USF led the Great Plains Athletic Conference in 12 statistical categories, including total offense and total defense. For his efforts, DeBoer was named GPAC Coach of The Year for the second consecutive season.

DeBoer has also been named the NAIA Region 4 Coach of the Year for the past two seasons (2006 & 2007). A graduate of USF, DeBoer played from 1993-96, where he was an All-American wide receiver, setting records for receptions (234), receiving yards (3,400) and touchdown catches (33).

Following his playing career, DeBoer served as a student assistant for the 1997 team that went 12-2 with an NAIA semi-final appearance.

In DeBoer's first season, he led the 2005 Cougars to an 11-2 record and their third semi-final appearance in the last four years. DeBoer continued the Cougar tradition as USF qualified for the playoffs for the 10th time in 12 years. His 11 wins that season are the most by any first-year head coach in the history of the USF football program since its birth in 1902.

DeBoer has led USF to at least a NAIA semi-final appearance in each of his three seasons. Overall, USF has made 12 of the last 14 NAIA playoff championship series.

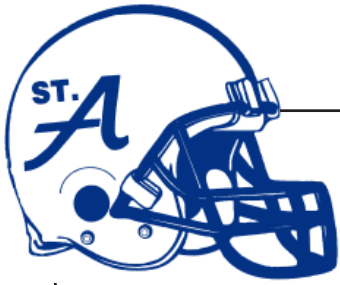

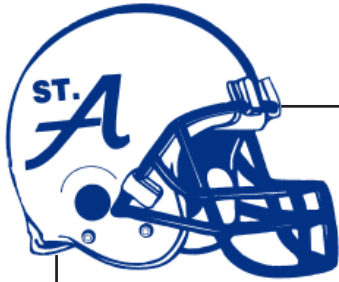

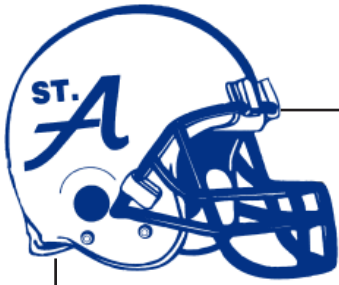
