

I. Requirements for the PSCI major (33 credits)

The following courses are required and are the core courses in the curriculum: PSCI 101; either PSCI 102 or PSCI 130; PSCI 120; PSCI 307 or 308; one of the following, PSCI 309, PSCI 313, PSCI 316, or PSCI 319; PSCI 380, PSCI 400 – WI, and STAT 213. If the student does not select a concentration (see below), the major is completed with 9 credits of electives of electives at the 300 level.

II. PSCI major with concentration in International Politics (33 credits)

The following courses (15 credits) are required for a concentration in international politics with a major in political science: PSCI 130, PSCI 309, PSCI 313, and two of the following PSCI 316, PSCI 319, or CRJU 499. Also, an approved set of international courses outside the major to complete general education requirements toward the interdisciplinary minor in international studies. Students should also double major or minor in another discipline with an emphasis on international studies such as history, foreign languages, etc. Consult with the Chair of PSCI and the Chair of the other Department or minor to approve program of study.

III. Requirements for the PSCI major with a concentration in Pre-law studies (33 credits)

The following courses (18 credits) are required for a concentration in pre-law studies with a major in political science: PSCI 110, PSCI 304, PSCI 307, PSCI 316, PSCI 360, CRJU 221. Also complete the interdisciplinary minor in pre-law. Program of study must be approved by the Director of Pre-law studies.

IV. Requirements for the PSCI major with a concentration in Public Administration and Leadership (33 credits)

The following courses (18 credits) are required for a concentration in public administration and leadership with a major in political science: PSCI 104; PSCI 308; PSCI 360 or 319; PSCI 365 or PSCI 375; PSCI 370 and PSCI 401. The student concentrating in public administration and leadership may substitute PSCI 360, administrative law, toward the major in lieu of an international politics course as normally required in the core. Public administration and leadership students are strongly encouraged to double major in another field related to public service, for instance sociology, criminal justices, psychology, etc. Public administration and leadership students should also complete an interdisciplinary minor related to their studies such as the organizational leadership minor, the environmental studies minor, or the pre-law minor. The interdisciplinary minor in leadership must include at least six credits toward the minor must be from outside the PSCI – LS curriculum. For approval of second major and interdisciplinary minor consult with PSCI Chair, the Chair of second major Department, and the coordinator/director of the appropriate interdisciplinary minor.

V. Requirements for the teacher education major in PSCI (39 credits)

The following courses are required:

PSCI 101, PSCI 102 , PSCI 120, PSCI 301, PSCI 304, PSCI 313, PSCI 365 or PSCI 375, PSCI 370 or PSCI 401, PSCI 380, PSCI 400, STAT 213; HIST 111, HIST 112.

VI. Requirements for a minor in Political Science (15 credits)

PSCI 101, PSCI 102 or PSCI 120 and 9 credits of electives six of the credits must be at the 300 level.
